Memo to: Prince Rupert Launch Masters

Subject: Coronavirus protocols

Given the concern over the spread of the Coronavirus, you are directed to implement the following protocols which were created during the SARS outbreak of 2003:

1. First, determine all inbound vessels' ports of origin. You may do this by contacting Prince Rupert MCTS and requesting this information. You may also search vessels online at <https://www.vesselfinder.com/> and look for 'Port Calls'.
2. Contact inbound vessels arriving from a high risk area by VHF at least two (2) hours prior to their arrival at Triple Island.

Note that the areas of high risk for the Coronavirus are China, Hong Kong, Taiwan, South Korea, Vietnam, Malaysia and Singapore.

If the vessel is from a high risk area, you are to ask the following questions:

1. Do you have any sick crew members on board?
2. If so, are they exhibiting the following symptoms: high fever, shortness of breath, dry cough or breathing difficulties?

If a ship from the high risk area answers in the affirmative to any of the above, you are directed to immediately contact Paulo Ekkebus, Brian Young or Bruce Northway and wait for their response prior to boarding the pilot.
